CERTIFICATE OF COLLABORATION
between
THE ROYAL INSTITUTION OF QUANTITY SURVEYORS MALAYSIA (RISM)
and
THE CANADIAN INSTITUTE OF QUANTITY SURVEYORS (CIQS)

The Royal Institution of Surveyors Malaysia (RISM) and the Canadian Institute of Quantity Surveyors see benefits to members of both professional bodies in establishing a Certificate of Collaboration between the two Institutions and agree to the following:-

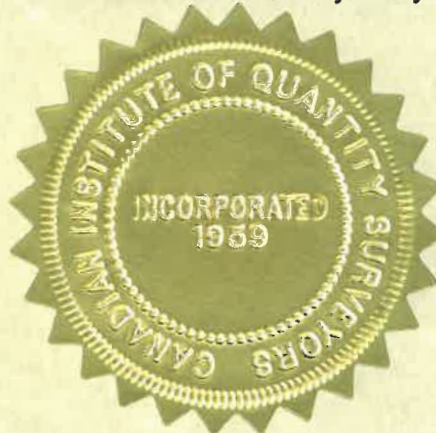
1. A member (Member or Fellow) of RISM in the QS Division in good standing with recognized qualification may be elected as a PQS/ECA member of CIQS subject to:
 - a) Completion of only the By-Laws, Rules, Regulations, and Ethics portion of the CIQS Test of Professional Experience, Practice Problem.
 - b) A professional interview conducted by the CIQS to determine the applicant's knowledge of Canadian Law and the practical application of the broad suite of applicable skills required of a certified Professional Quantity Surveyor (PQS).
 - c) Subsequent election to PQS/ECA being subject to the By-laws and Regulations of CIQS.
2. A PQS/ECA member of CIQS in good standing with recognized qualifications may be elected as a member of the RISM QS Division subject to:
 - a) A professional competence interview conducted by RISM to assess and confirm the applicant's knowledge of law and practice in Malaysia.
 - b) Subsequent election to Fellowship is subject to the Bye-laws and Regulations of RISM.
3. Any member who wishes to practice in Malaysia must satisfy the registration requirements of the Board of Quantity Surveyors Malaysia.
4. Irrespective of the above, each professional body reserves the right to deny membership or extend the practice period for any applicant under this agreement when, in the opinion of that body, the applicant does not satisfy all their educational or membership criteria.
5. RISM and CIQS will build and maintain a long-term cooperative relationship and encourage the exchange of professional knowledge and development.
6. RISM and CIQS will collaborate in:
 - a) Co-branding of Continuing Professional Development (CPD) events and offering members of RISM and CIQS the same rates for such events.
 - b) Sponsorship of professional events.
7. The RISM and CIQS will notify each other in respect of any proposed material constitutional or educational changes and any proposed merger with other professional bodies.
8. The leadership of RISM and CIQS will meet at least once every three years or earlier to discuss matters of common interest.
9. RISM and CIQS will keep each other informed of major changes that interest the other.
10. Each professional body warrants that it is not under the ownership or control of any designated persons or entities under the other's country's sanctions law, and further warrants to notify the other if it comes under such ownership or control.
11. This Reciprocity Agreement will remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the date of signature thereof, whereafter the Agreement will be subject to review and renewal by mutual agreement of the respective parties.
